The City of Duluth is excited to announce the upcoming downtown walking path and traffic-calming project planned for the Willbrooke Subdivision. Within the next 30 days, Duluth will complete acquisition of 3545 McClure Woods Drive. Following acquisition, the existing home will be demolished to make way for a new pocket park and future pedestrian path connection into the adjoining downtown residential development (see attached concept graphic). In addition to construction of the pocket park and path, traffic calming measures will be installed along two sections of McClure Woods Drive to assist with safer pedestrian crossings. The pocket park and traffic calming measures should be completed in 12 months with the connection path into the downtown residential development scheduled to open in 24 months. Once completed, the Willbrooke Subdivision will have a direct walking path to Town Green, City Hall, Red Clay Theatre, downtown Duluth shops/restaurants and the future Duluth Library.
